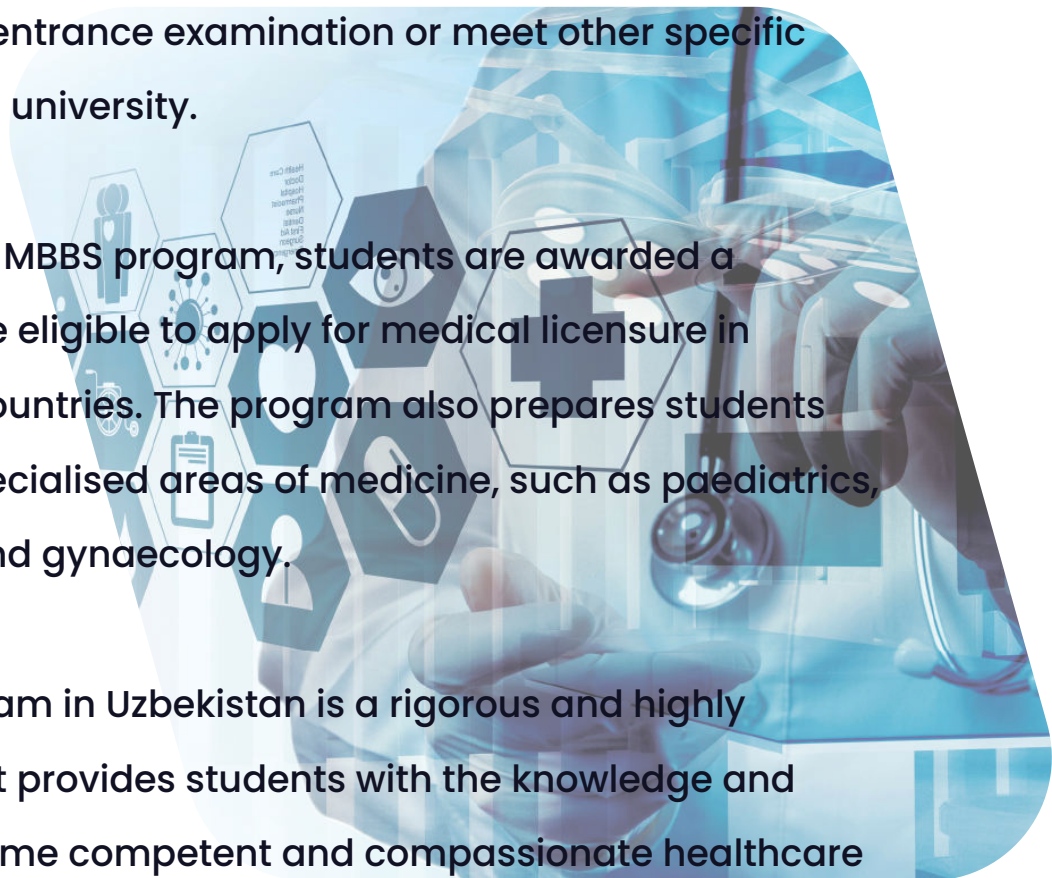
# MBBS in Uzbekistan

- 10+2 exam with a percentage of 50% for General category students.
- 10+2 exam with a percentage of 45% for OBC/SC/ST
- Age of the candidate should be 17 years as on 31st December of the year

## Subjects should be :

- Physics
- Chemistry
- Biology
- And also must have English as a compulsory subject during the course of study.
- Students must have cleared the NEET examinations.

# Medical education system in Uzbekistan

The medical education system in Uzbekistan consists of undergraduate and postgraduate programs. Undergraduate programs in medicine typically last for 6 years and lead to the award of a Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) degree. # Accommodation and fooding for indian students in uzbekistan ;

- All medical universities in uzbekistan provide separate girls and boys hostel in campus with all facilities CCTV , laundry, electricity , wifi,Indian hostel warden to help indian students.

## Cost of Living for Indian students in Uzbekistan.

- The cost of living in Uzbekistan for Indian medical students can vary depending on the location and lifestyle of the student. However, on average, the cost of living in Uzbekistan for Indian medical students is relatively low compared to other countries.

### Accommodation:

- Renting a one-bedroom apartment in a city centre can cost around 300,000-350,000 UZS (\$35-40) per month.
- Renting a one-bedroom apartment outside of the city centre can cost around 200,000-250,000 UZS (\$23-30) per month.

### Food:

- Groceries can cost around 100,000-150,000 UZS (\$12-18) per month.
