Romania, located in southeastern Europe, is a country with a rich history, stunning landscapes, and a vibrant culture. Romania covers an area of 238,391 km², compared it is somewhat smaller than the United Kingdom (242,900 km²), or slightly smaller than the U.S. state of Oregon. Romania has a population of 19.8 million people (2015), capital and largest city is Bucharest, with a population of 2 million people.

Romania joined NATO in 2004 and the EU in 2007. Now it's a Schengen member state. Romania's strategic location along the Black Sea and its commitment to strong transatlantic relations have made it a key partner for both the EU and the United States in the region

EU Membership:

Joining: Romania became an EU member state on January 1, 2007. Since then, it has actively participated in EU institutions and decision-making processes.

The official currency of Romania is the Romanian Leu (RON). The country has committed to adopting the euro once it fulfills the necessary conditions.

Schengen Member: Romania is also a member of the Schengen area, which means that air and sea border controls have been lifted as of March 31, 2024.

Geography and Landscape

Carpathian Mountains: The Carpathians dominate the central part of Romania, offering breathtaking views, lush forests, and opportunities for outdoor adventures.

Black Sea Coastline: Romania has a small but picturesque coastline along the Black Sea, providing sandy beaches and a pleasant climate.

Danube River: The Danube flows through Romania, connecting it to other European countries.

Historical Significance

Diverse Influences: Romania's history has been shaped by various empires, including the Roman, Ottoman, and Austro-Hungarian. These influences are reflected in its architecture, traditions, and cuisine.

Great Union: On December 1, 1918, Romania achieved the Great Union, uniting Transylvania, Bessarabia, and Bukovina into a single state.

Communist Era: From 1948 to 1989, Romania was under communist rule, led by Nicolae Ceaușescu. The fall of communism in 1989 marked a significant turning point.

Education and Opportunities

MBBS Programs: Doctors passing out with Romanian Medical Council registration which gives them status of EU/EEA registered doctors and have equivalency to practice anywhere in EU /EEA including UK and Ireland with B2 level language certificate of respective countries .

Affordability: Compared to other European countries, tuition fees and living costs in Romania are relatively affordable.

Multicultural Environment: Studying in Romania provides exposure to a diverse student community and a chance to explore European culture.

Culture and Traditions

Folklore: Romania boasts a rich folklore tradition, with colorful costumes, lively dances, and hauntingly beautiful music.

Cuisine: Romanian cuisine features hearty dishes like sarmale (cabbage rolls), mămăligă (cornmeal porridge), and cozonac (sweet bread).
